Service Above Self

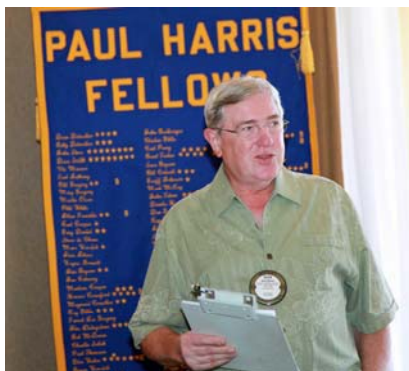
